WHAT TO EXPECT

When coming to AdventHealth Imaging Services, here is what you can expect:

- **Locations**

Many of our services are offered at multiple locations. We will inform you of your options at the time of scheduling. Location information is available on the back of this card.

- **Radiology Appointments**

Convenient and extended appointment times are available. This allows you to choose a date and time that works for you.

- **Medically Emergent STAT Appointments**

When your provider orders a STAT radiology screening, we will work closely with you on scheduling the exam the same day, if possible.

- **Walk-In Appointment (X-Ray Only)**

With a walk-in appointment, you will need to register at the front desk. An estimated time will be provided when you arrive. Average wait time for a walk-in appointment range from 30 minutes to one hour.

- **Screening Mammogram**

Schedule your mammogram online at AdventHealthKC.com or call Outpatient Scheduling.

PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS

- **MAMMOGRAM:** Do not use deodorants, powders, sprays, or ointments under the arms or on the breast the morning of the exam.
- **SMALL BOWEL SERIES:** Take 2 Senekot Tablets at 6:30 PM the evening prior to the exam. Nothing to eat or drink after midnight. Avoid gum chewing and smoking.
- **COLON X-RAY EXAM:** Obtain a Fleets #1 prep kit (available at most pharmacies) 2-3 days before your exam. Follow the 24-hour prep instructions included in the kit.
- **STOMACH X-RAY - UGI:** Nothing to eat or drink after midnight the evening before and the morning of your exam.
- **CT CONTRAST STUDY:** If you need lab work, arrive 45 minutes prior to exam. If patient has an iodine allergy, ordering provider must provide patient with prescription.
- **CT NO IV CONTRAST STUDY:** No restrictions.
- **CT ABDOMEN OR CT PELVIS OR CT ABDOMEN/PELVIS:** If ordered with oral contrast, arrive **1.5** hours prior to your exam.
- **ULTRASOUND PELVIS AND/OR OB:** For pelvic area and obstetrical exams, drink 32 oz. of water to be completed **one** hour before your exam. A full bladder is needed to visualize pelvic organs.
- **ULTRASOUND ABDOMEN AND/OR GALLBLADDER:** For gallbladder and abdominal studies (kidneys, liver, and pancreas), eat a low-fat meal the evening before (no butter, cream, etc.). Nothing to eat or drink after midnight the night before your exam.
- **DXA BONE DENSITOMETRY:** No preparation. No calcium or multivitamins in the morning.
- **MRI:** You do not need to discontinue any medication and there are no dietary restrictions for most MRI studies. Please remove any objects that may be attracted to or damaged by a magnet. This may include jewelry, credit cards, hearing aids, dentures, etc. Our staff will secure these items in a locker during your examination. Certain individuals with cardiac pacemakers, brain aneurysm clips, a history of metallic fragments in an eye, or certain other implanted devices may not be candidates for MRI due to safety concerns. Please inform the technologist if you believe any of these conditions apply to you. If a patient has a continuous glucose monitor, they will need to remove it for their exam.
- **MRCP:** Nothing to eat or drink after midnight.
