

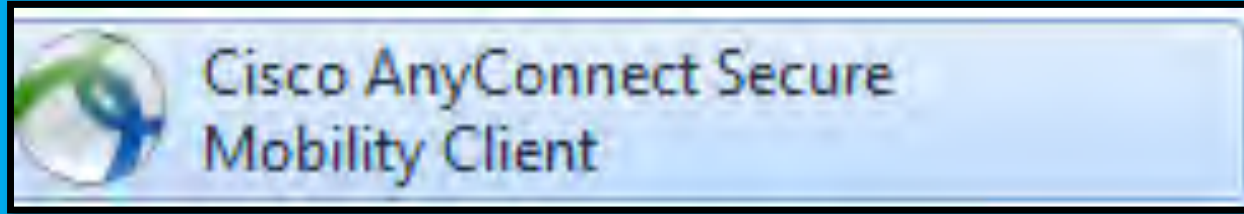

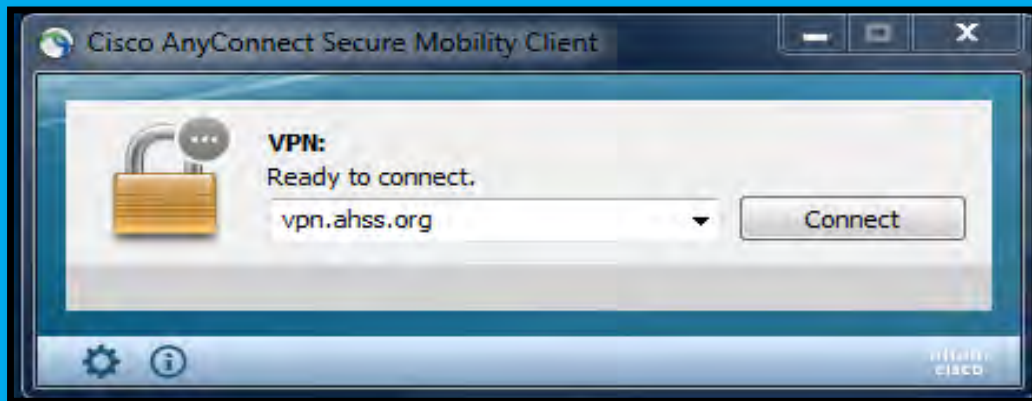

Access VPN via SecureAuth OTP

- ⦿ When launching the CISCO VPN your icon will display as follows:

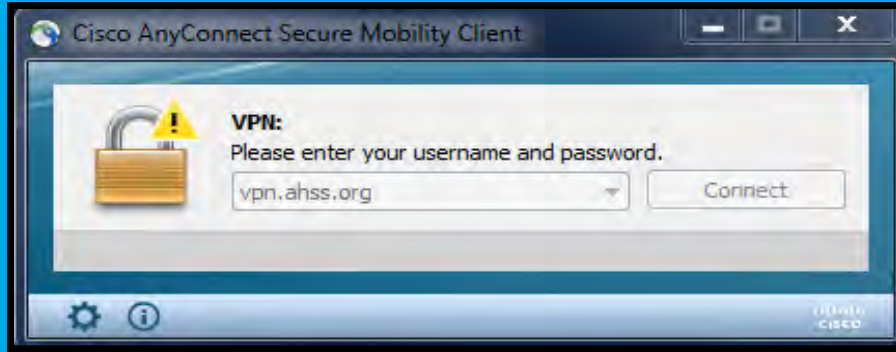


- ⦿ Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client will appear.

 - Select Connect

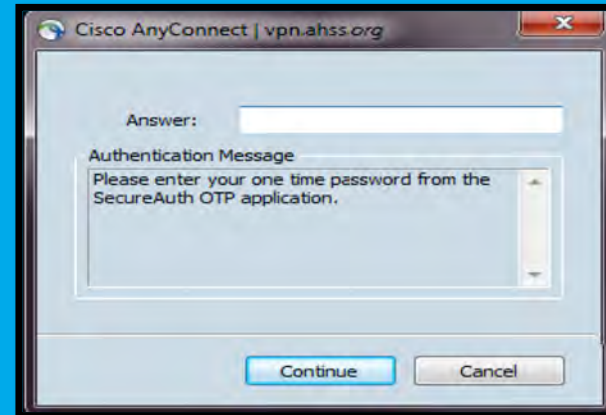


Access VPN via SecureAuth OTP

- Login by inputting your OPID and Password.

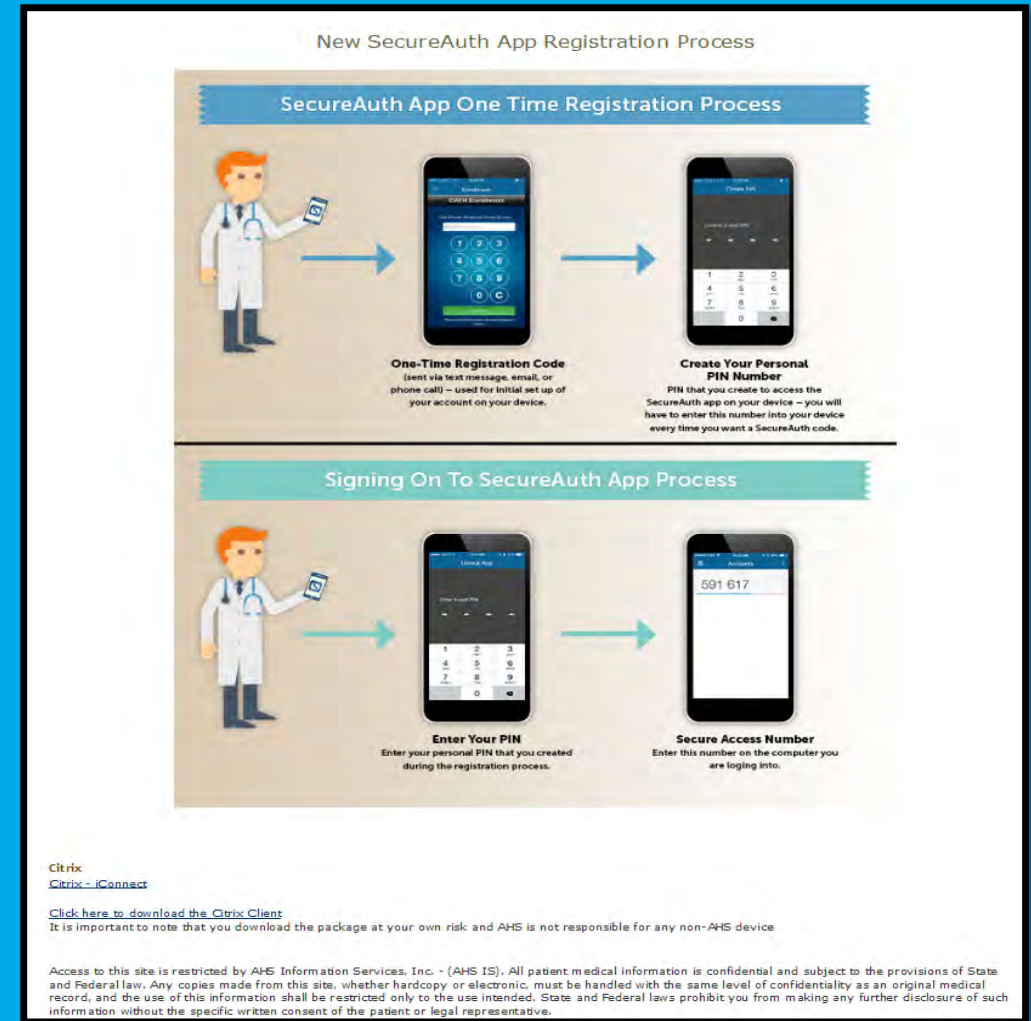


- You will then be prompted to enter the SecureAuth password.



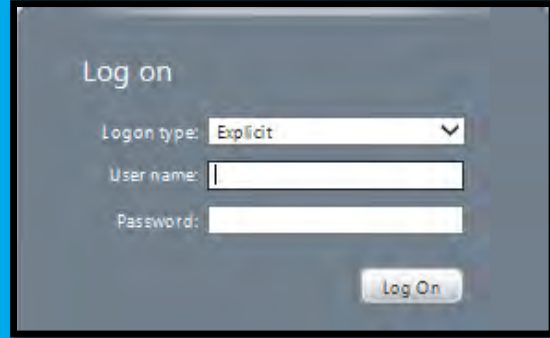
Access VPN via SecureAuth OTP

- Once in Citrix- iconnect you will need to log in with your OPID and password.

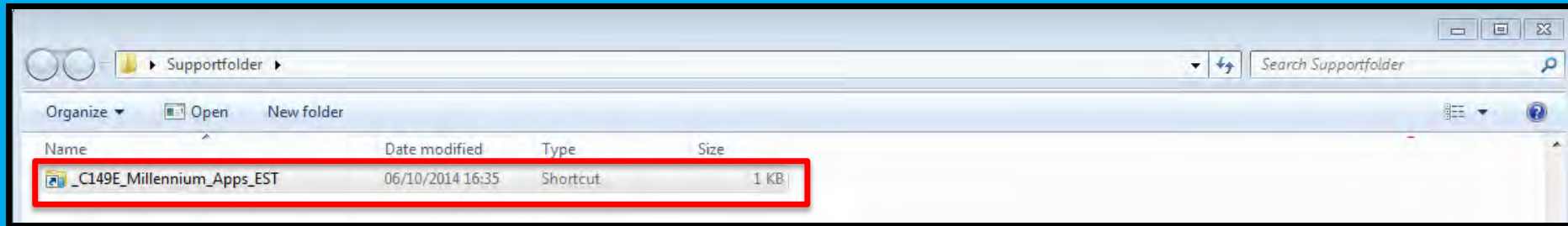


- PowerChart application tools will be displayed.

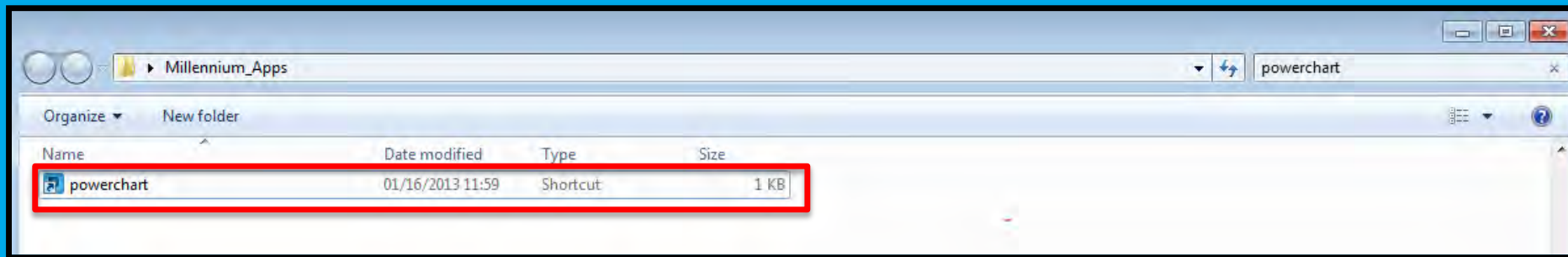


Accessing PowerChart (cont.)

- After selecting the appropriate domain, click on the “Millennium Apps” folder:




- Once in “Millennium Apps”, select “PowerChart” (you can also type “powerchart” in the search field and it will bring you directly to the icon).
