

- Advance screening for heart disease

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WholeMe is a first-of-its-kind DNA study in Florida that will empower consumers with potential life-saving information about their heart health.

In partnership with Helix, a personal genomics company, participants will be able to learn about traits that may impact their daily life, such as lactose tolerance, caffeine metabolism and sweet tooth. Their DNA will also be evaluated for the genes linked to familial hypercholesterolemia (FH) – a genetic condition that causes high cholesterol. If left untreated, it can lead to a heart attack, even in young adults.
