

Throughout her decades of support, Brea has played a crucial role in securing significant gifts, including those that led to the creation of the Walt Disney Pavilion at AdventHealth for Children and the SMILE with Stella Tremonti Down Syndrome Clinic. AdventHealth for Children has raised a remarkable \$46M toward impacting the lives of our littlest patients. Brea is also the first woman to hold the position of foundation executive board chair, and she also serves as foundation board chair at AdventHealth for Children. Brea mobilizes resources and inspires others to advance world-class, whole-person care at AdventHealth in Central Florida. Thank you, Brea, for your boundless passion, magical touch of pixie dust, and your true heart of gold.

Impact Icon

AdventHealth honored Shawn Bush, President, CEO, and co-founder of ICON, with the Impact Icon Award for his generous contributions, innovative leadership, and lasting impact on the community. Shawn Bush and his family generously established the Bush Family Acute Cardiac Surgical Unit, which expanded to a 32-bed unit, providing lifesaving ECMO support during the COVID-19 pandemic. They also funded the Bush Family Cardiovascular Fellowship Program, supporting cardiology fellows and subspecialists. Physician Champion

Dr. Lopez has been a key partner with AdventHealth Foundation Central Florida, helping secure millions in donations since joining AdventHealth for Children. His dedication to improving pediatric head and neck cancer care inspired a \$1M gift to establish the first pediatric head and neck training program. His passion for making a difference is



evident whether he's advocating for funding, welcoming donors and students, or serving on medical mission trips. Dr. Lopez was recognized for his contributions to expanding research, improving clinical outcomes, and training future surgeons to care for our most vulnerable patients.

Community Catalyst

The Vosburg family was recognized with the Community Catalyst award for their dedication, significant mobilization of community support and resources, and substantial contributions to AdventHealth's mission.

Melissa's Race began in 2016 in memory of Melissa Vosburg, a beloved teacher and Sanford resident. The race has grown into the largest brain cancer charity 5K in Central Florida. Last year marked the tenth annual event organized by Melissa's family and friends. Over the last decade, the Vosburg family's efforts have generated \$610,000 to advance brain tumor research at AdventHealth Cancer Institute. Thank you to the Vosburg family for their ability to inspire others and foster a spirit of collaboration with the community.

Attendees were deeply moved by Curtis' emotional story of receiving a double lung




transplant and Mattie's family's journey of her life-saving liver transplant at just nine-months old. Mattie's precious waves and kisses blown from stage were the evening's highlight.
