BLOOD DONATION CONSENT FOR 17-YEAR-OLD DONOR

AdventHealth Blood Center suggests that Blood Donors who are 17 years of age but not yet 18, and are dependants, have permission from a parent or legal guardian before donating blood. This is a one-time only requirement.

Donors should eat a well-balanced meal, including plenty of fluids (avoid caffeine), 3 – 4 hours prior to donation.

Blood donation consists of drawing approximately 500 ml. (about 1 pint) of blood from the donor. A medical history is taken. The donated blood is tested for exposure to Syphilis, Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C, HIV (the virus that causes AIDS), HTLV (a rare virus that can sometimes cause leukemia or neurological disease), T. Cruzi (the causative agent for Chagas Disease), West Nile Virus, and Zika Virus.

Donating blood is safe and usually there are no side effects. On rare occasion donating blood may cause fainting, weakness, sweating, dizziness, pallor, hematoma, hyperventilation or bruising. None of these symptoms are life threatening and may or may not occur with subsequent donations. Be assured that the Blood Center personnel are trained to recognize and treat any symptoms that might occur. You cannot get AIDS from donating blood.
