



Safety is the highest priority at AdventHealth for Children. The following guidelines will help us keep your child safe.

### Family Presence

- We welcome and encourage parents to be with your child as much as possible, 24 hours a day.

### Visiting Hours (8am-8pm)

- Screening will be completed before entering the unit for all parents and visitors.
- Up to three healthy visitors (including siblings) may be at your child's bedside at one time.
- Siblings under 18 years of age may visit during regular visiting hours with adult supervision.
  - Minor siblings must be able to comply with hand hygiene and masking requirements.
  - Accommodations will be made for breastfeeding infants.
- To protect our patients and visitors, visitation may be limited during peak times of illness in the community like RSV, FLU or COVID-19.
- Virtual visitation options will be provided if visitation is restricted.

### Infection Prevention

- To keep your child safe, we recommend all caregivers wash hands often, especially before and after visiting a patient.
- Visitors must comply wearing appropriate Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) and masking when indicated for patients on transmission-based precautions.
- Please postpone non-urgent visits if you're experiencing cold and/or flu-like symptoms.
  - Visitors with respiratory illnesses may be denied entry to the unit.

### Zero Tolerance

- Aggressive language and behavior will not be tolerated.
- No weapons, alcohol, recreational drugs, lighters, or flammable liquids permitted.
