CENTER FOR INTERVENTIONAL ENDOSCOPY (CIE)

The AdventHealth Center for Interventional Endoscopy is a state-of-the-art unit providing tertiary level endoscopic services for patients with complex digestive diseases.


Our endoscopists are trained in cutting-edge techniques and the latest technologies available for the endoscopic management of digestive disorders.


The team advances collaborative research not only within the AdventHealth System, but globally to further the treatment and knowledge of digestive diseases.

For patients requiring advanced endoscopic procedures, our GI team collaborates closely with the CIE endoscopists to treat them, thereby providing a one-stop shop with no traveling or multiple consultations necessary.


Patients are referred to CIE for tertiary-level endoscopic care from across the United States as well as internationally. In 2019, patients were referred from 10 countries and 28 states nationwide. More than 50% of treated patients originated from outside the Tri-County area.

INFLAMMATORY BOWEL DISEASE


The IBD program is designed to provide multidisciplinary clinical care and to rapidly translate research breakthroughs into treatments. The program brings together many specialists – medical gastroenterologists specializing in IBD, colorectal surgeons, radiologists, nutritionists, pathologists, psychologists, wound care (stoma) specialists, researchers, nurses, and others with the shared goal of implementing a comprehensive, evidence-based approach to care for our patients.

The mission of the program is to provide state-of-the-art comprehensive care for patients with complex inflammatory bowel disease (IBD), to be at the forefront of research and foster cutting-edge clinical trials of the latest treatment options.

Our clinical trial developmental program enables us to improve existing therapies and provide novel treatment for patients with ulcerative colitis and Crohn's disease. Additionally, we place special emphasis on the endoscopic management of IBD complications that include strictures, fistulae and leaks. We utilize chromoendoscopy and confocal imaging to investigate early-stage neoplasia and offer endoscopic mucosal resection as a treatment option.

UPCOMING PROGRAMS

Fatty Liver Disease

The planned Fatty Liver Disease Clinic will offer a multidisciplinary approach, including:

- A liver specialist to ensure that complete and appropriate testing is done to establish the right diagnosis
- Individualized diagnostic testing and therapeutics
- Individualized treatment plans, including medical, surgical and behavioral therapies

At AdventHealth Medical Group Fatty Liver Disease, our program offers a multidisciplinary approach, where the experts are brought to our patients so they have access to complete care from the onset. A liver specialist will ensure that complete and appropriate testing is done to establish the right diagnosis. We offer individualized diagnostic testing as well as therapeutics. The patient's physician will determine the right treatment plan in each case.

Our specialists actively collaborate with the AdventHealth Clinical Research Institute, where studies are currently being conducted to better understand this disease and develop improved treatments. We are dedicated to taking care of the whole patient and remain committed to providing the best care possible for each individual and their family.

Paracentesis

Paracentesis is a procedure to remove abnormal fluid buildup in the abdomen caused by a complication of cirrhosis. The creation of this clinic, for patients with



chronic liver disease or cirrhosis, will save the patient multiple visits to the ER and ensure the procedure is done in a safe manner.

Gastroenterology & Hepatology Fellowship Program
AdventHealth strongly believes in training the next
generation of gastroenterologists to be leaders in
patient care and research. This three-year program will
allow fellows to:

- Gain experience treating patients with complex GI disorders, including: motility problems, chronic liver disease, transplant evaluations, IBD, endoscopy and colonoscopy evaluations
- Learn from experts in the field across multiple specialties, including CIE and colorectal surgery

Chronic Liver Disease (non-transplant)

The Chronic Liver Disease (non-transplant) Clinic will offer specialized treatment throughout the long-term management of liver failure.

- A liver specialist will guide appropriate care management to improve quality of life.
- We will provide individualized treatment plans, which include lifestyle modifications, medical management, and therapeutic interventions.
- We will work closely with other medical specialties to provide therapeutic options including medical weight loss, esophageal variceal banding, gastric varices glue injection, radiofrequency ablation of portal hypertensive gastropathy, TIPS, therapeutic paracentesis and bariatric surgery.
- Care coordination with our multidisciplinary transplant team will be provided if and when the need arises.
- We will develop care coordination pathways with radiology, outpatient clinic providers and inpatient medicine to arrange for timely interventions, thus minimizing ER visits, hospitalization and length of stay in the hospital.

Our chronic liver disease program provides a liver specialist who partners with each of our patients to optimize their health while managing this irreversible disease. As with our other featured programs, we provide whole-person care for every patient in pursuit of the best possible outcomes.

PATIENT-CENTRIC PARTNERSHIPS

As part of the AdventHealth Care Network, we offer ourselves as a "one-stop shop" supporting all gastroenterology and GI surgical needs. The team works with specialists in other fields to ensure the patient is cared for, with the least amount of traveling or multiple visits. This results in efficient care and minimizes delays. Examples of these partnerships include:

- CIE: for patients needing advanced procedures
- Transplant Hepatology: for patients that require transplant evaluation, including lung, blood and bone marrow transplants
- Colorectal Surgery: for patients with abnormal colonoscopies or who have been diagnosed with colorectal cancer
- Oncology: for patients with malignancies, including collaboration with surgical, medical and radiation oncology
- General Surgery: for patients who require surgical intervention for motility disorders, including foregut surgery
- Comprehensive Imaging Services, including:
 - Timely studies
 - A vast network of locations, increasing patient convenience
 - Accurate diagnoses from experienced radiologists
 - Minimized delays in care
- Primary Care Providers: providing consults within 24-48 hours to primary care physicians who have patients presenting with GI disorders. A new pilot program will test virtual consults between our physicians on call, during office hours.
- Integrated Pelvic Floor Program: Collaborative program with urogynecology and colorectal surgery to diagnose, treat and manage pelvic floor disorders
- Inflammatory Bowel Disease Treatment: for patients with complex IBD cases
- Fatty Liver Disease: coordinating a multidisciplinary approach, including nutrition, transplant hepatology and weight loss medicine for patients with non-alcoholic fatty liver disease



PEDIATRIC GI

Our pediatric gastroenterology team uses some of the most advanced medical techniques to diagnose problems in children associated with the stomach, bowels, liver or nutritional health. Our team works in a highly collaborative environment, leveraging the collective expertise of more than 30 sub-specialties. We diagnose and treat a wide range of conditions including failure to thrive, short gut syndrome, celiac disease, eosinophilic esophagitis, obesity, liver disorders, achalasia, Hirschsprung's disease and inflammatory bowel disease.

Liver Transplant

In order to make lifesaving pediatric-liver transplants available throughout Central and North Florida, AdventHealth for Children has partnered with the UPMC Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh to develop Orlando's first-ever pediatric liver transplant program. This truly exciting endeavor fulfills a critical need for children across Florida to have access to a liver transplant program that's close to home. Today, our transplant surgeons, medical specialists and nurses work closely with their colleagues from Pittsburgh to perform pediatric liver transplant surgeries and provide essential follow-up care for kids right here in Central Florida.

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
