Emergency Care

An emergency room is the best place to seek treatment when significant symptoms come on suddenly or could be life-threatening.

Emergency symptoms include:




- Change in mental status
- Chest pain or other heart symptoms
- Choking
- Coughing up or vomiting blood
- Fractures with severe pain, deformity or a visible bone
- Head or spine injury
- Loss of consciousness
- Major trauma, injury or burn
- Seizures
- Severe abdominal pain or pressure
- Severe or persistent vomiting
- Snake bites
- Stroke symptoms
- Sudden dizziness, weakness, or change in vision
- Sudden, severe pain anywhere in the body
- Swallowed a poisonous substance
