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

Level III NICU

It even provides a private room for each baby with parent sleep areas.

Special Care for Your Needs

If you and your baby should need an extra level of care, we provide expert consults with maternalfetal specialists dedicated to high-risk pregnancies. We also have in-house OB/GYNs available 24/7 who assist mothers in emergency situations until their physician arrives, and also provide monitoring for moms who choose to have a vaginal birth after a previous Cesarean section (VBAC).
